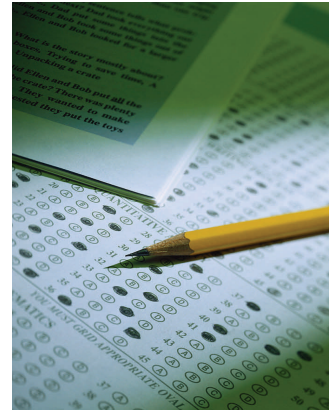


Preventing Behavioral and Academic Failure & State Assessment Systems: What are schools doing now, and what should parents know?
