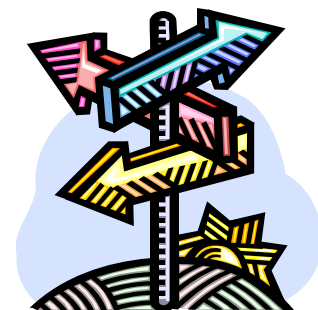


# Age of Majority for Students with Disabilities And Understanding Social Security
