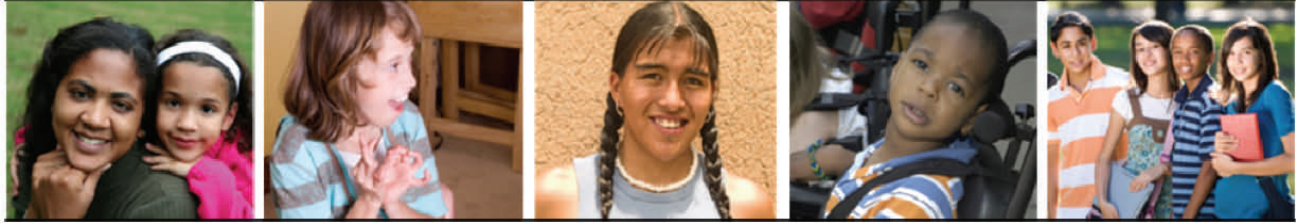


“Skills for Effective Parent Advocacy”
