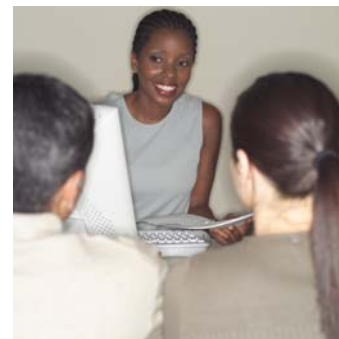


What Every Parent Needs to Know About the IEP
