

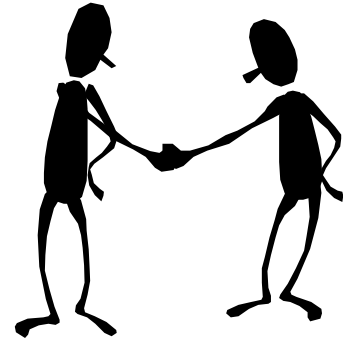
IEP Partners Training

This intensive two-day training is for people who would like to become volunteers for OrPTI and support other parents at their IEP meetings.

Training includes:

- IDEA
- IFSP/IEP
- Transition from High School
- Behavior and Discipline in Schools
- Principles of Communication
- Parent/Professional Partnership
- Statewide Assessment Options
- Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act



Once trained, the IEP Partners may be matched with parents requesting support at their IEP meeting. The IEP Partner will receive a stipend for every IEP meeting they attend on behalf of the Oregon Parent Training & Information Center.
